



An Update from Rapid City Regional Airport Regarding COVID-19

As of Friday, October 23, 2020

We encourage all airport users to practice personal responsibility and social distancing while visiting the Rapid City Regional Airport (RAP). **Facial coverings are required while in the terminal and are required by all of our air carriers for air travel.** There are currently no quarantine requirements for inbound travelers at the airport.

Airport Cleanliness

In addition to our regular cleaning schedule, we have implemented a very robust cleaning program that includes continuous cleaning and disinfecting of all areas in the terminal during normal operating hours. This includes all high touch points such as handrails, door handles, elevator call buttons, hold room seating areas, trash bins, water fountains, etc. Other elements of our program include:

- Overnight UVC treatment using state-of-the-art contact-less sterilization equipment effectively killing viruses, germs, bacteria, fungi & more
- Overnight electrostatic disinfectant fogging
- Floor decals and other signage to encourage social distancing
- Messaging promoting wearing of face coverings
- Hand sanitizing stations located throughout the terminal
- Shield guards at airport businesses, ticket counters, and gate podiums
