



Ford TriMotor to Visit Rapid City Regional Airport

RAPID CITY, S.D. (6/5/18) -- The Rapid City Regional Airport and the local Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) will once again welcome the EAA Ford Tri-Motor to the airport June 21-24, 2018. A free General Aviation Open House will also be held on Saturday, June 23.

The Ford Tri-Motor, known as the “Tin Goose,” is one of the first luxury airliners from the 1920s. Rides on the historic aircraft will be available throughout the tour and can be purchased by calling 1-877-952-5395 or visiting www.flytheford.org. Seats are limited so interested persons are encouraged to make their reservation early.

As part of the Open House, a wide variety of aircraft will be on display and visitors will have an opportunity to learn more about the airport’s role in the community. Guided aircraft tours, static aircraft displays and booth presentations will provide an opportunity to learn more about general aviation from pilots and other specialists in the field. Displays will include new airplanes, experimental aircraft, aerobatic aircraft, corporate aircraft, helicopters, Life Flight aircraft, gliders and more.

This family activity (Open House) is open to the public and free of charge. It will begin at 9:00 AM and run until 2:00 PM. Lunch will be available from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM with a free will donation.
